

Directions for "Perseverance Strategies Spinner"




I. Cut out the spinner parts.




2. Line up the spinner parts.



3. Insert a brad on the dot in the middle.




4. Bend the parts of the brad.




For Use:

- -Students can color or decorate the black and white spinner, or it can be printed on color paper.


Perseverance Strategies Spinner Base




Perseverance Strategies Spinner Topper
