


This poster can be used as a visual aid for the activities in this resource, or displayed in your classroom or office!

Students will look at 12 scenarios and determine whether or not they are examples of tattling. This activity is provided as 2 worksheets, and also as 12 clip cards.



Kids will learn about things that they can do instead of tattling.


They will look at 10 scenarios and decide which strategy would be best in that situation.
