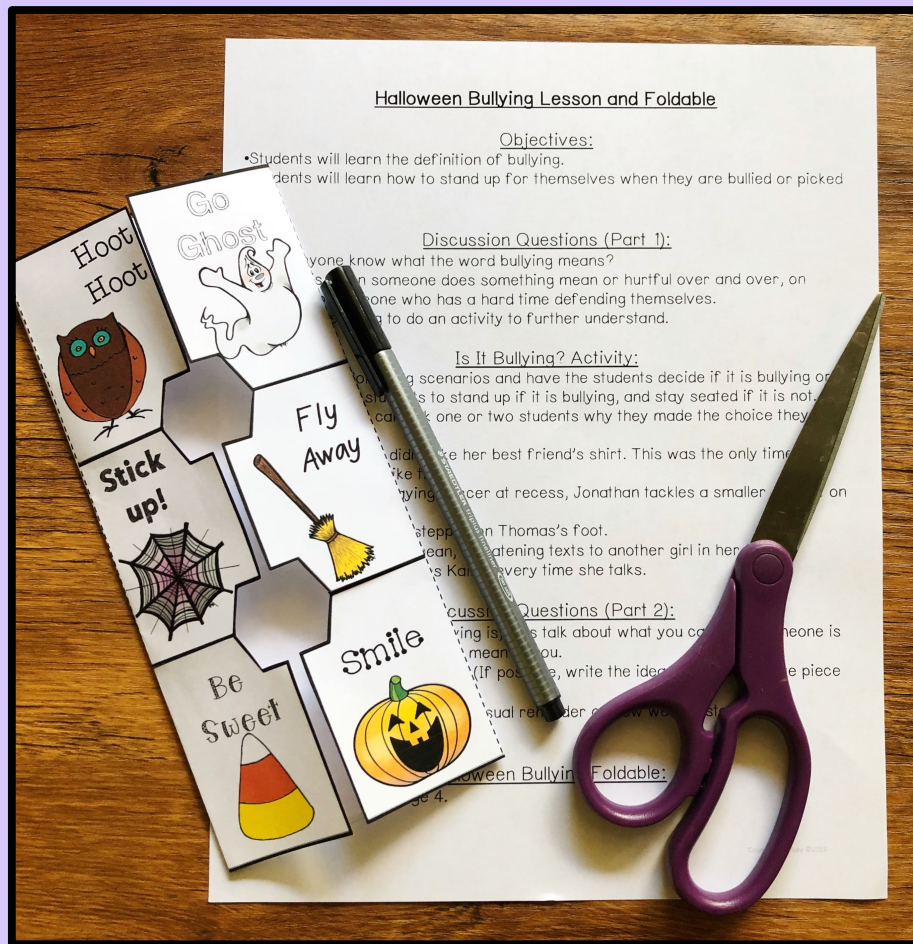


# Engage your students in learning about bullying prevention with this Halloween themed lesson!

**Halloween Bullying Lesson and Foldable**

**Objectives:**  
Students will learn the definition of bullying.  
Students will learn how to stand up for themselves when they are bullied or picked on.

Does anyone know what bullying is when someone purposefully, to someone who is weaker than they are, is doing it to them?  
Now we are going to do an activity.

Read each of the following stories and decide if it is bullying. Instruct the students to raise their hand if it is not. If time permits, discuss the stories with them.

- 1) Lilo said that she didn't have a friend. She said something like that to her friend.
- 2) Every day while playing soccer, Jamal was picked on by the other players.
- 3) Jameer accidentally stepped on someone's foot.
- 4) Rihanna sent several mean text messages to her friend.
- 5) Lucas purposely ignored his friend.

Now that we know what bullying is, let's make a foldable to help us remember how to stand up for ourselves.  
Does anyone have any ideas?
