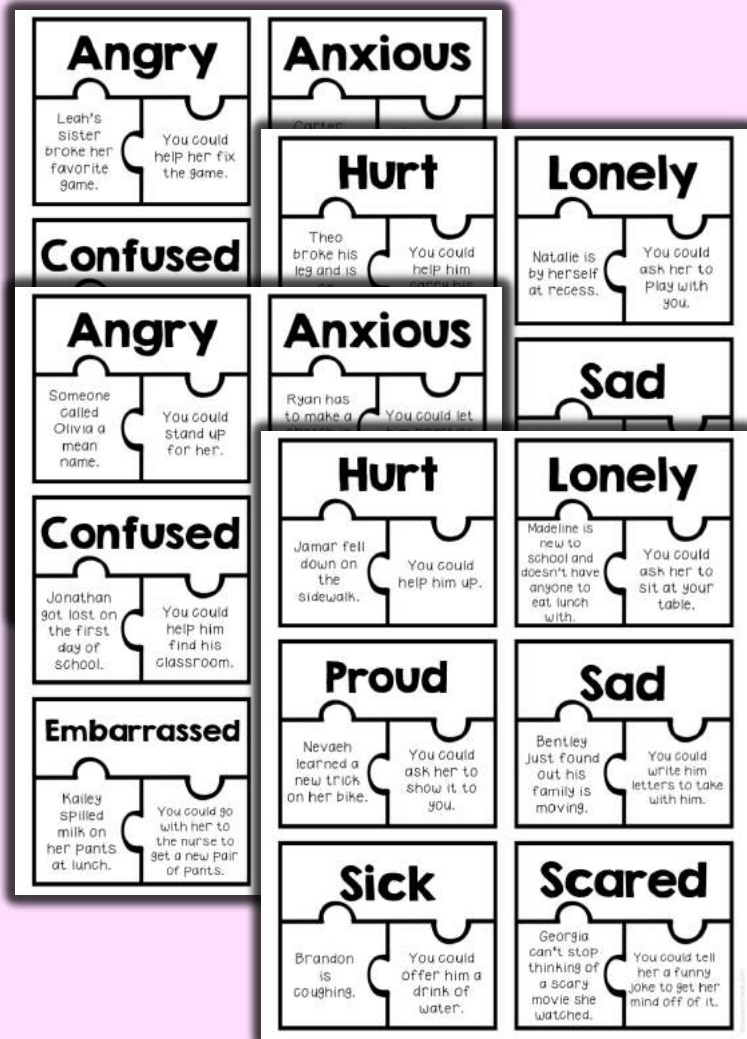


INCLUDES 24 PUZZLES

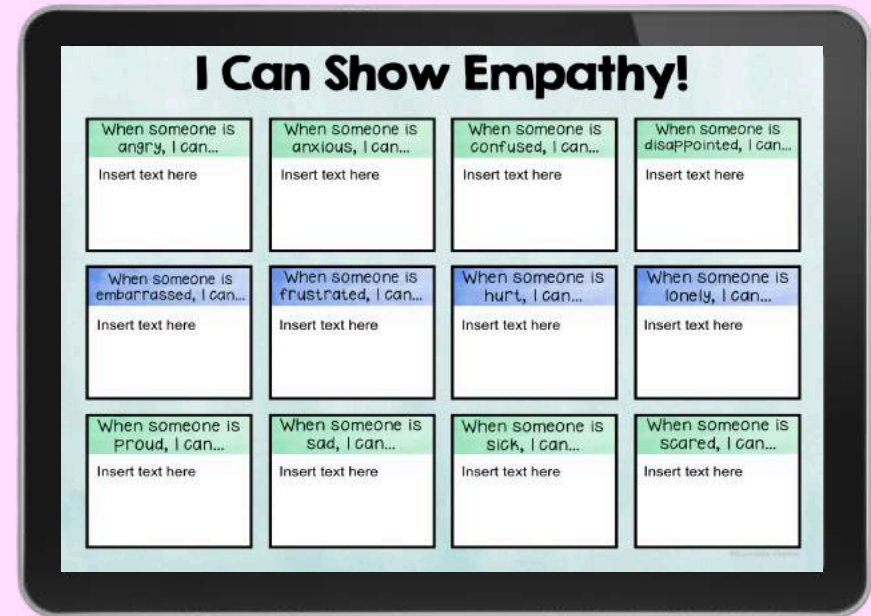
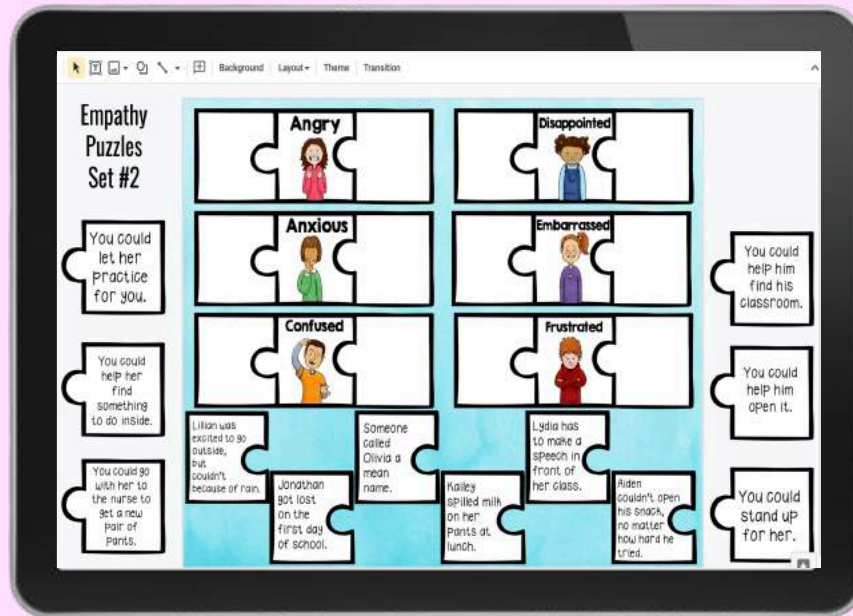

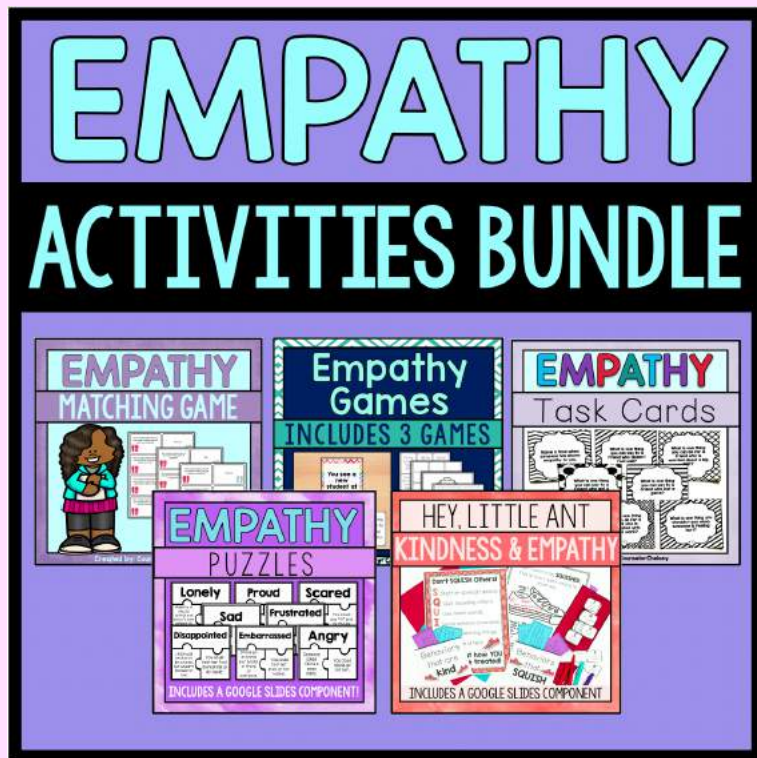
