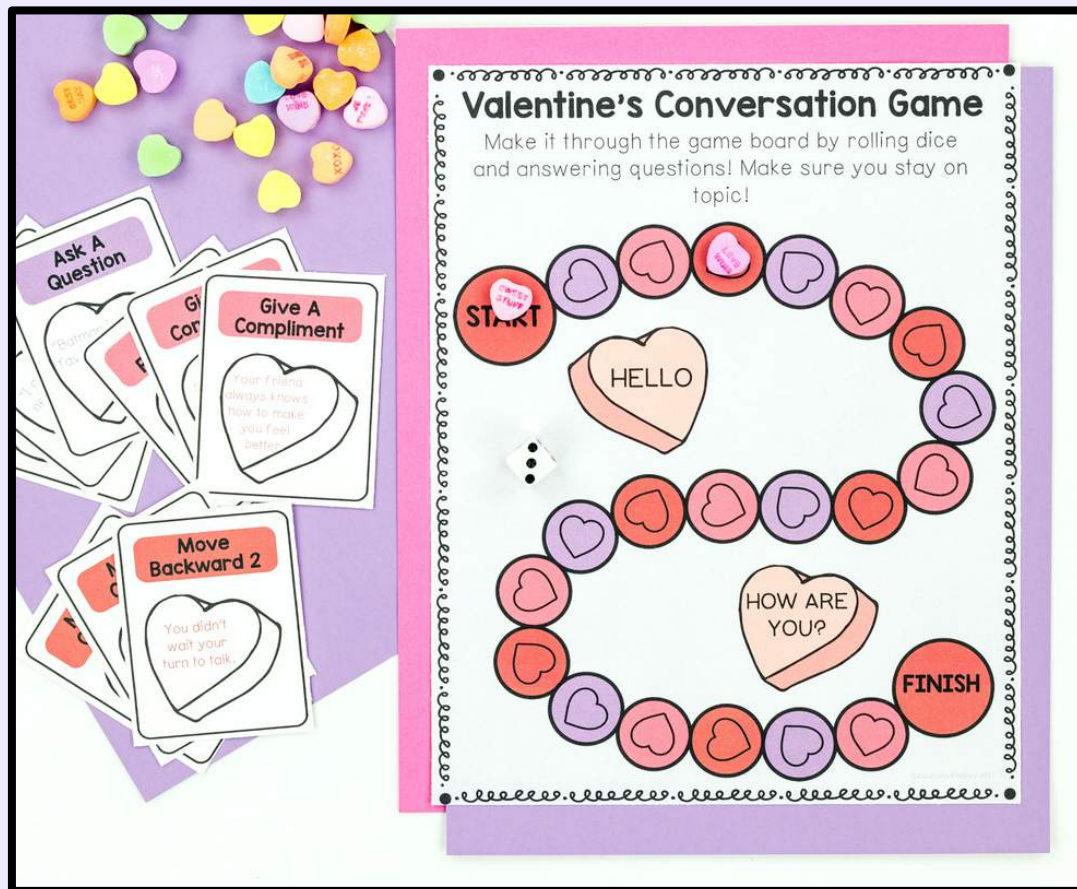


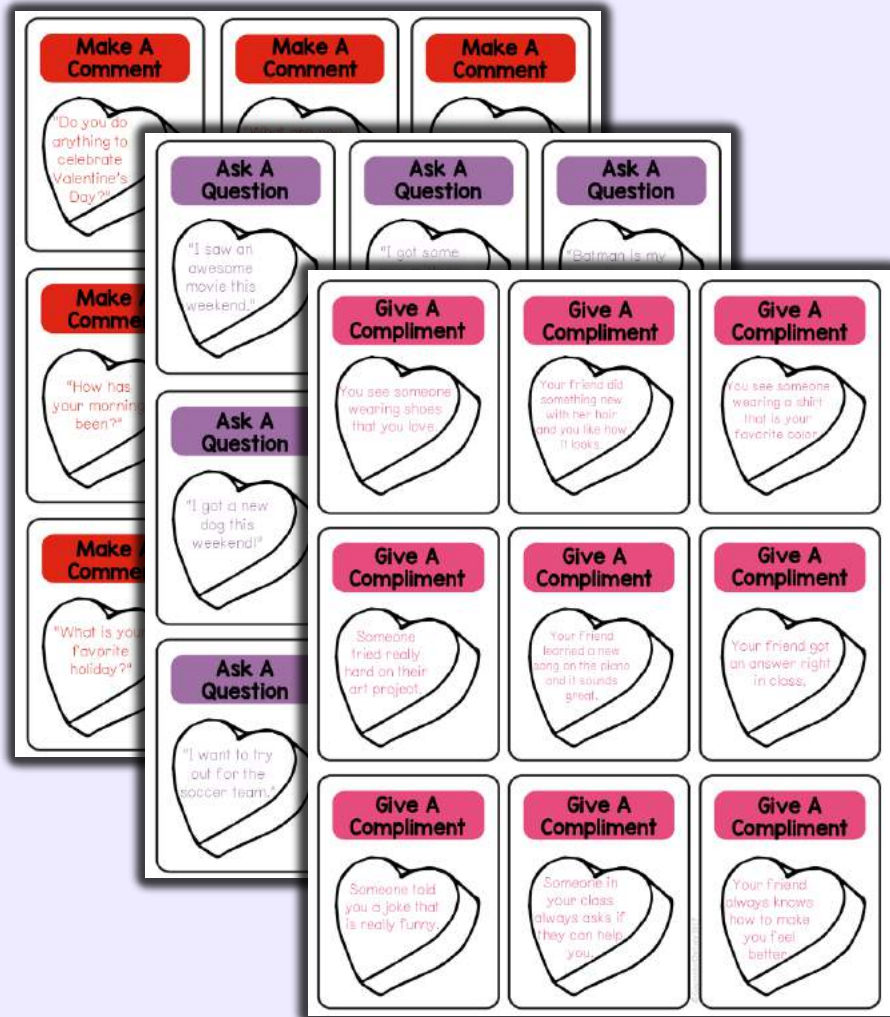
# Help students practice their conversation skills with this Valentine's themed game!

- Students who have Autism or social anxiety

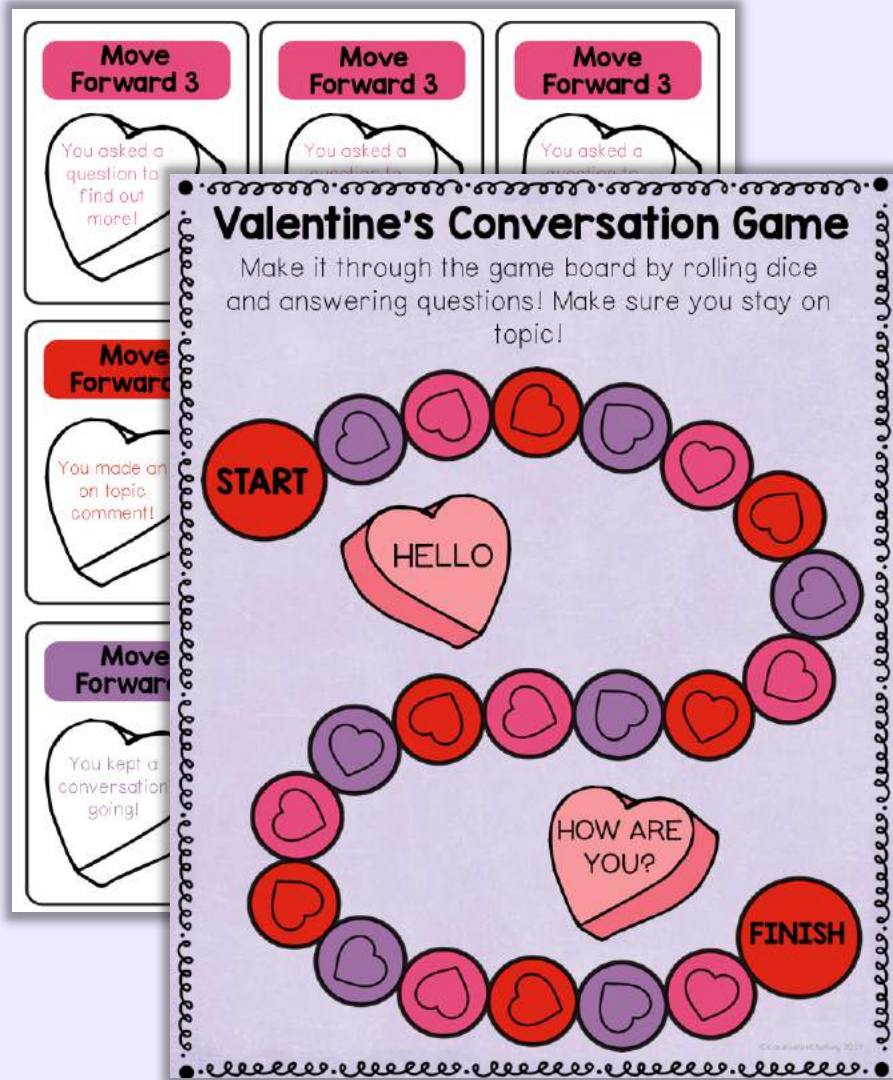
# 54 PROMPT CARDS

There are 18 prompt cards for each of these concepts.

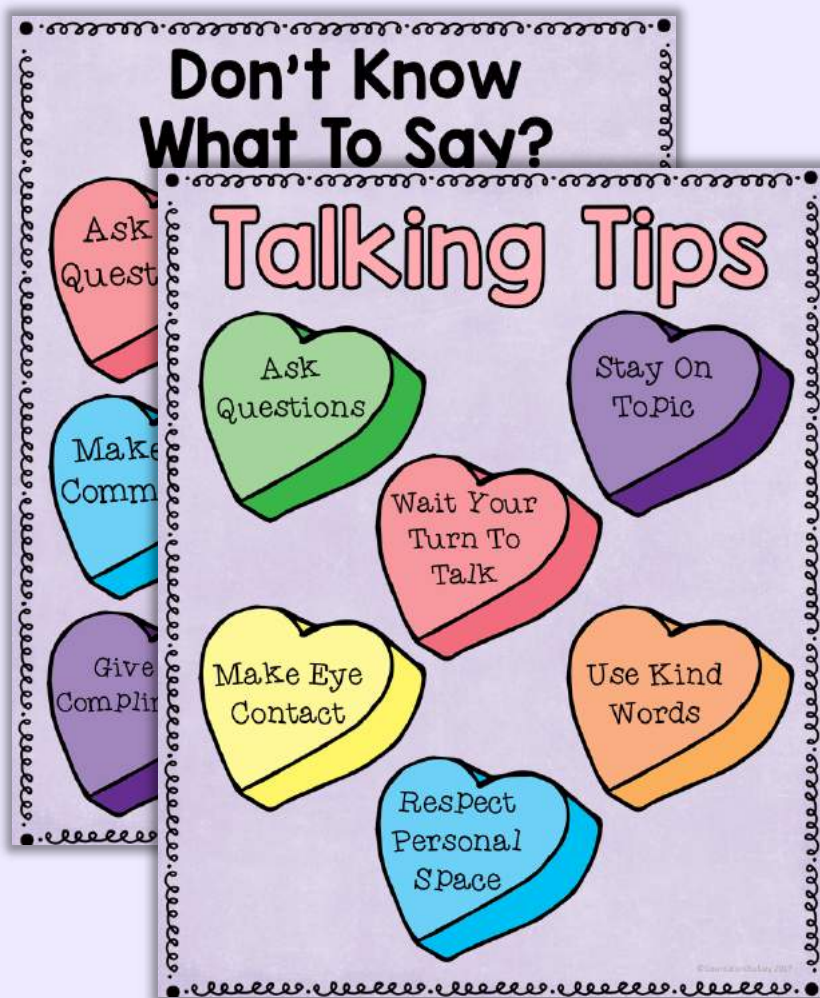
# GAME BOARD & GAME CARDS
