
Why use cut & paste activities:

How to use cut & paste activities:


- Cut and paste activities can be used in individual, small group or classroom settings.

"Speaking Respectfully"




Students will look at 12 scenarios and determine whether the sayings are respectfulor disrespectful.

Students will look at 12 scenarios and determine whether the actions are respectfulor disrespectful.


