
Use these activities to help your students learn to embrace mistakes!

These activities can be used with or without the book <u>Beautiful Oops!</u> By Barney Saltzberg




Growth Mindset Booklet


This 6 page booklet will give students an opportunity to consider how mistakes can be made beautiful!
