

Use these activities to help your K-2 students learn the definition of bullying so they can spot bullying when they see it!


18 CLIP CARDS


A SORTING ACTIVITY



The instructor will read through scenarios and the students will share whether or not they think it is an example of bullying by holding up the corresponding sign.




