

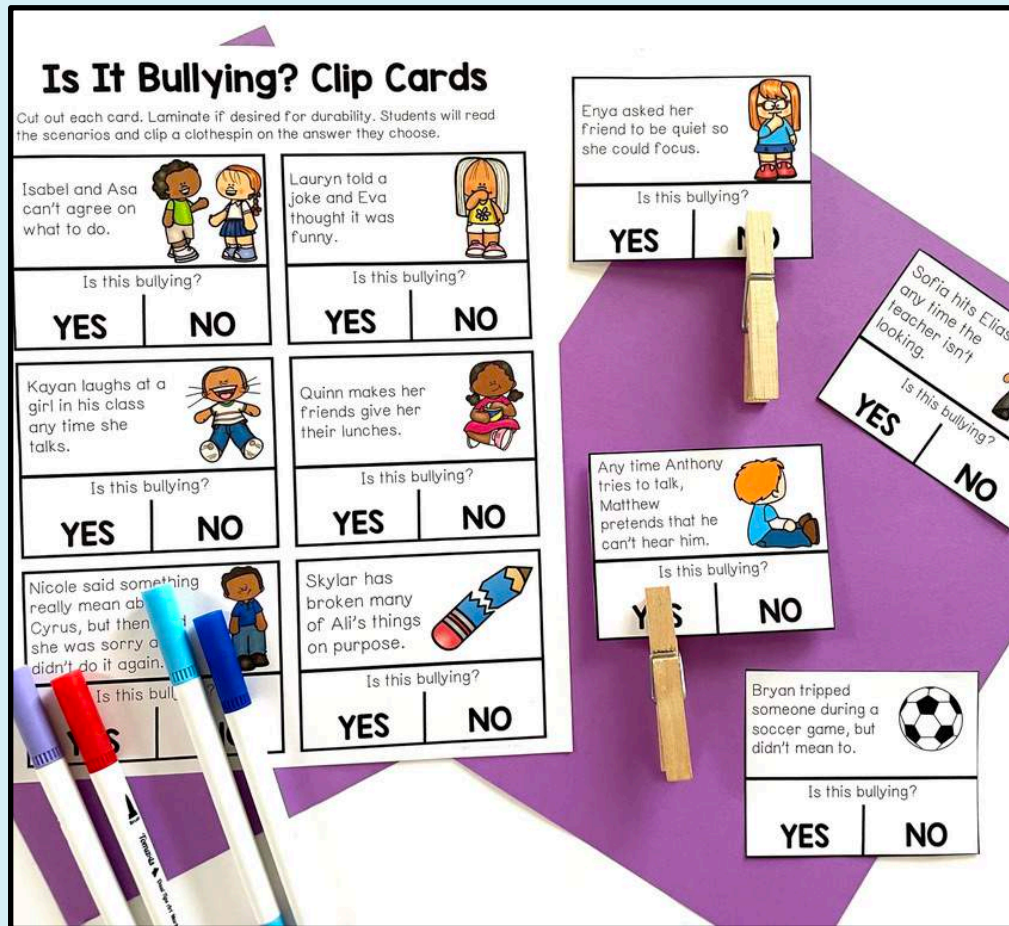
Use these activities to help your K-2 students learn the definition of bullying so they can spot bullying when they see it!

Students will look at 18 scenarios and decide whether or not they are examples of bullying. They can place a clothespin on each card to show their answer.

A SORTING ACTIVITY

Is It Bullying? Sorting Activity

Objectives:
Students will identify what bullying is.


Materials:
Signs from page ____ (Color) or B&W
Scissors (optional)
Popsicle Sticks (optional)

Activity:
Cut out the signs from the next page. Attach each one to a popsicle stick. When the instructor reads the scenarios, the students decide whether or not it is bullying. They can vote by holding up their signs. If you have time, you can fold the sheet in half and have students vote by holding up the corresponding sign.


Scenarios:

- 1) Every day on the bus, Thomas sits down. (Yes)
- 2) Finn and Corey were arguing. (Yes)
- 3) Emma tells all of her friends that she likes to be friends with her. (Yes)
- 4) When Mona is around Ezra, she says mean things. (Yes)
- 5) Libby was mad at her friend. (Yes)
- 6) Izzy says mean things about her friend. (Yes)
- 7) Paula and Leta don't get along. (Yes)
- 8) Nora accidentally stepped on someone's foot. (No)
- 9) Theo took Emmy's book, but she didn't mind. (No)
- 10) Lydia is scared of Noah because he is going to punch her. (Yes)
- 11) Anytime Carolina tries to talk to Owen, he can hear what she's saying. (No)
- 12) Sarah told Owen that she didn't like his team because he had enough players. (No)

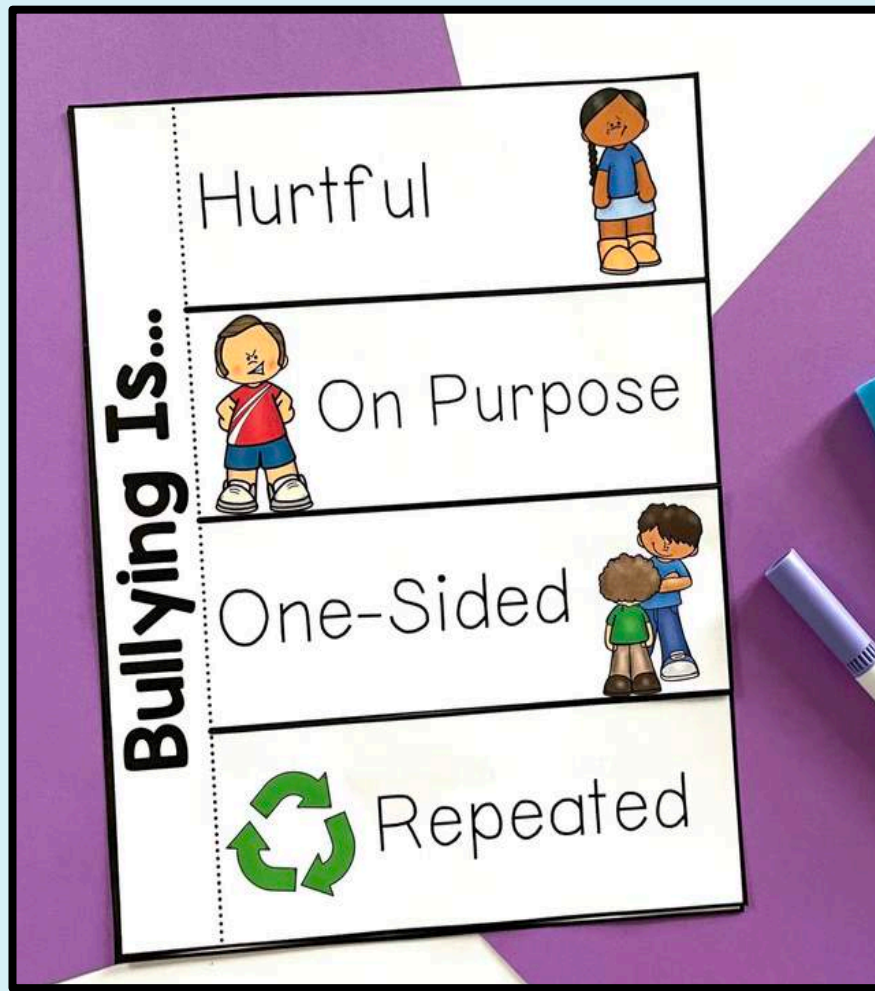

FOLDABLE ACTIVITY



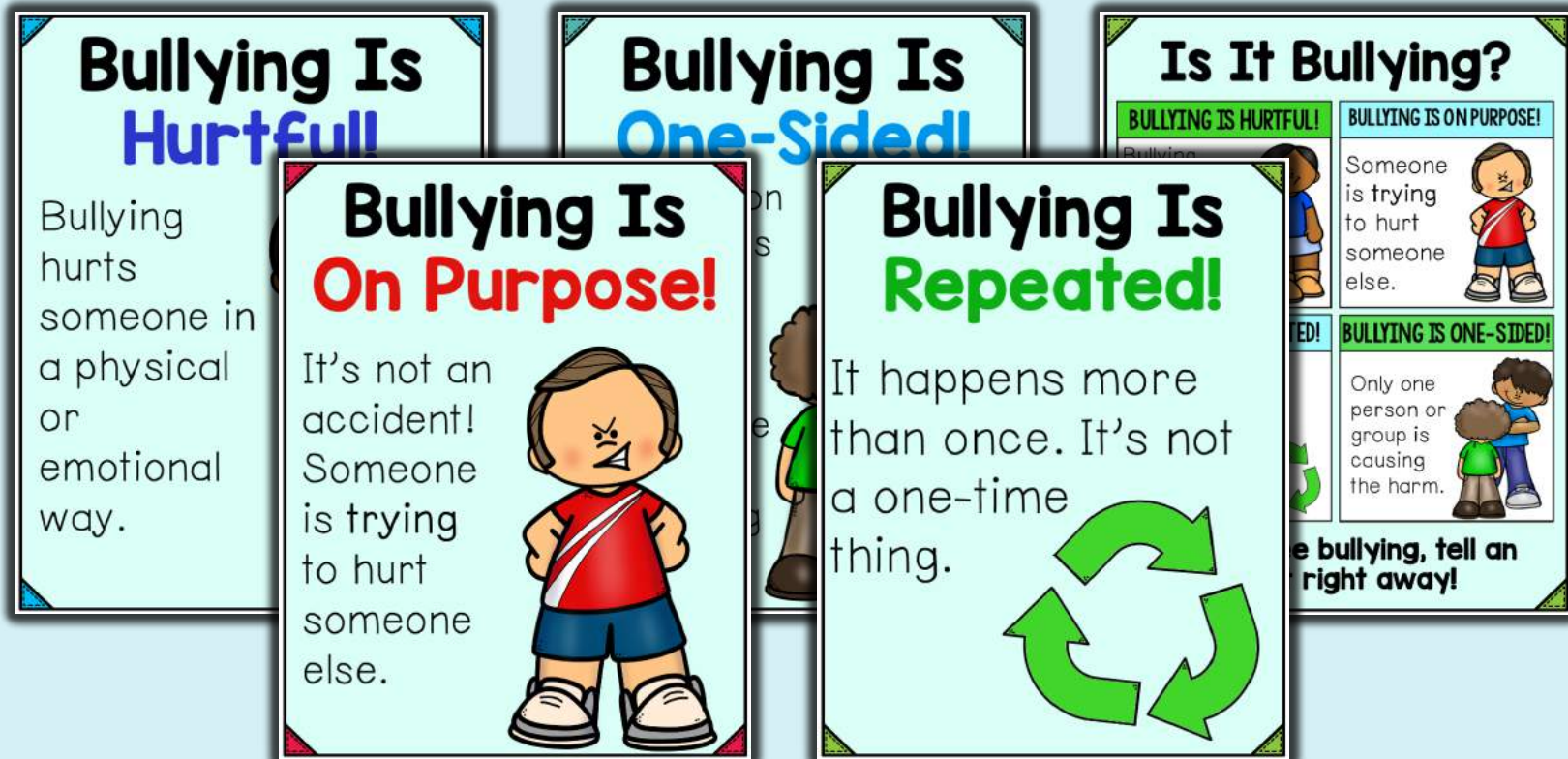
Comes in color and B&W

There are 4 posters that each explain a criteria of bullying. There is also a poster with all 4 criteria explained. The posters also come in black and white!



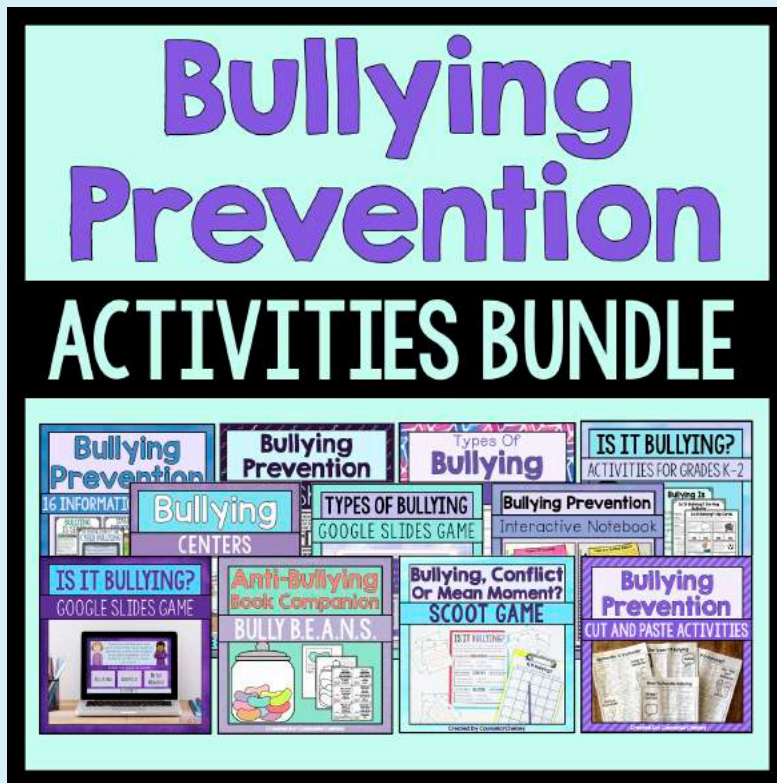
