

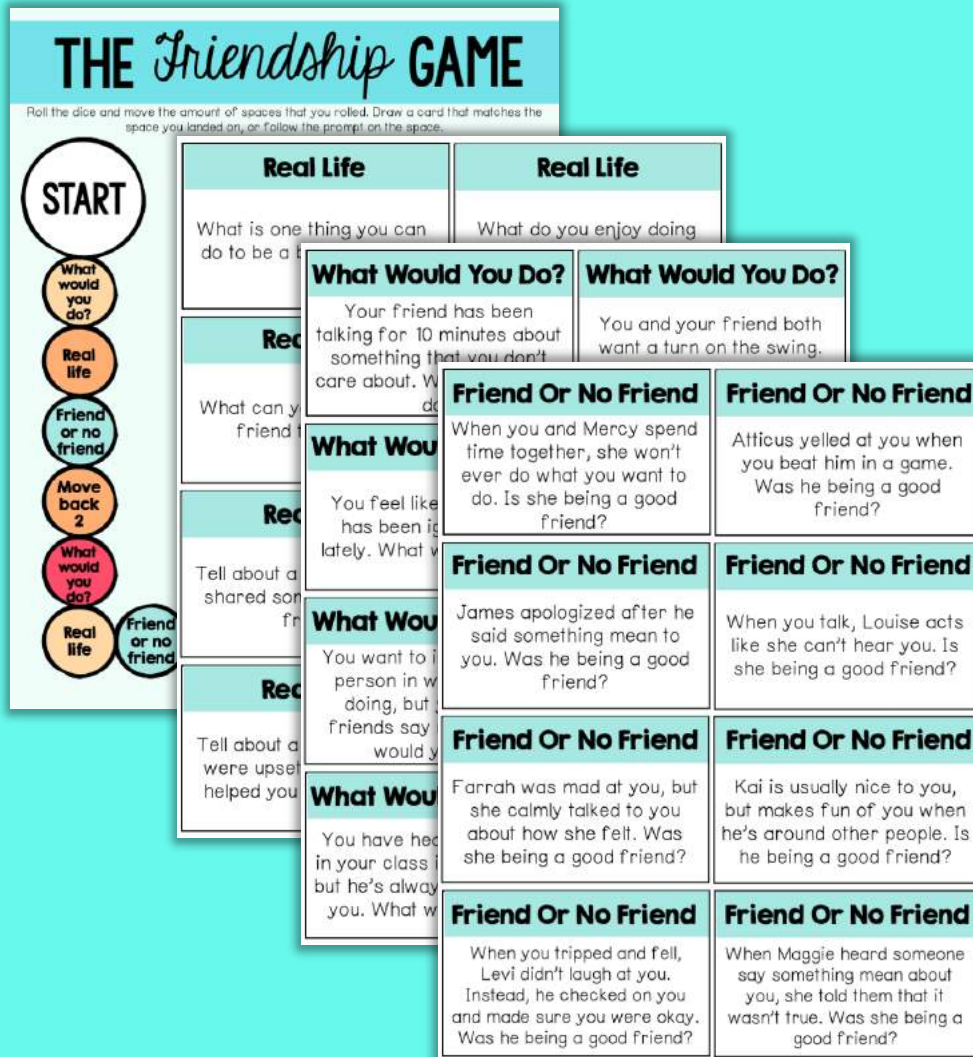
Use these games to help your students build and practice their friendship skills!

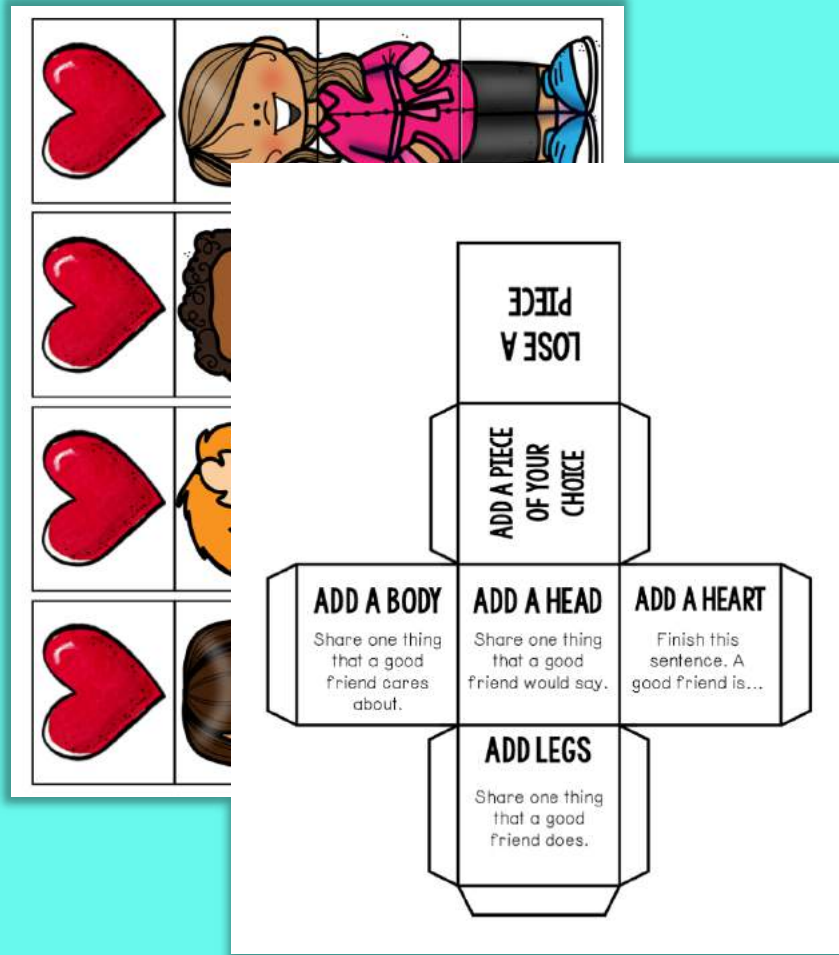

Students will respond to various friendship prompts with answers that begin with the same letter! Includes a sheet with four different cards.

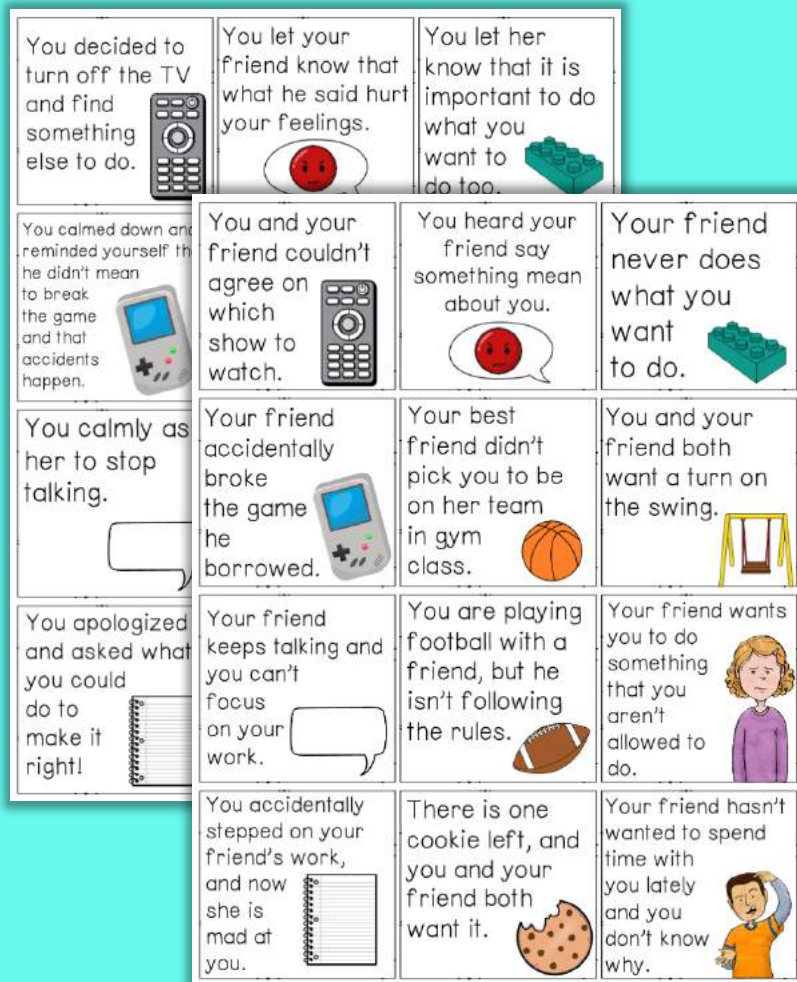
Includes A “Build A Friend” Game



Players will roll a dice as they race to see who can build their friend the fastest! Each time they roll, they will add the corresponding piece and answer the discussion question.

Includes A Conflict Resolution Matching Game



Students will look at various scenarios and consider how the problems can be resolved peacefully.

Cards will be cut out and placed face down. Players will take turns turning them over, trying to find the problem and its matching solution.
