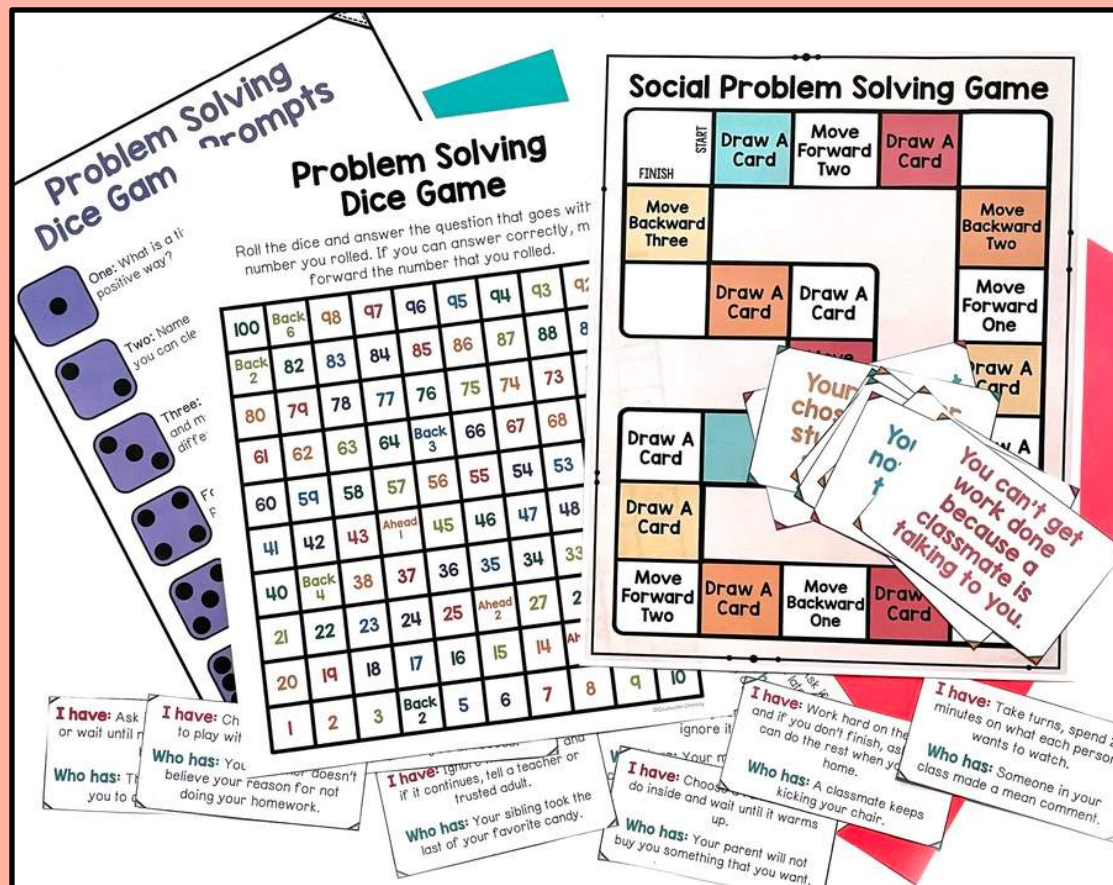


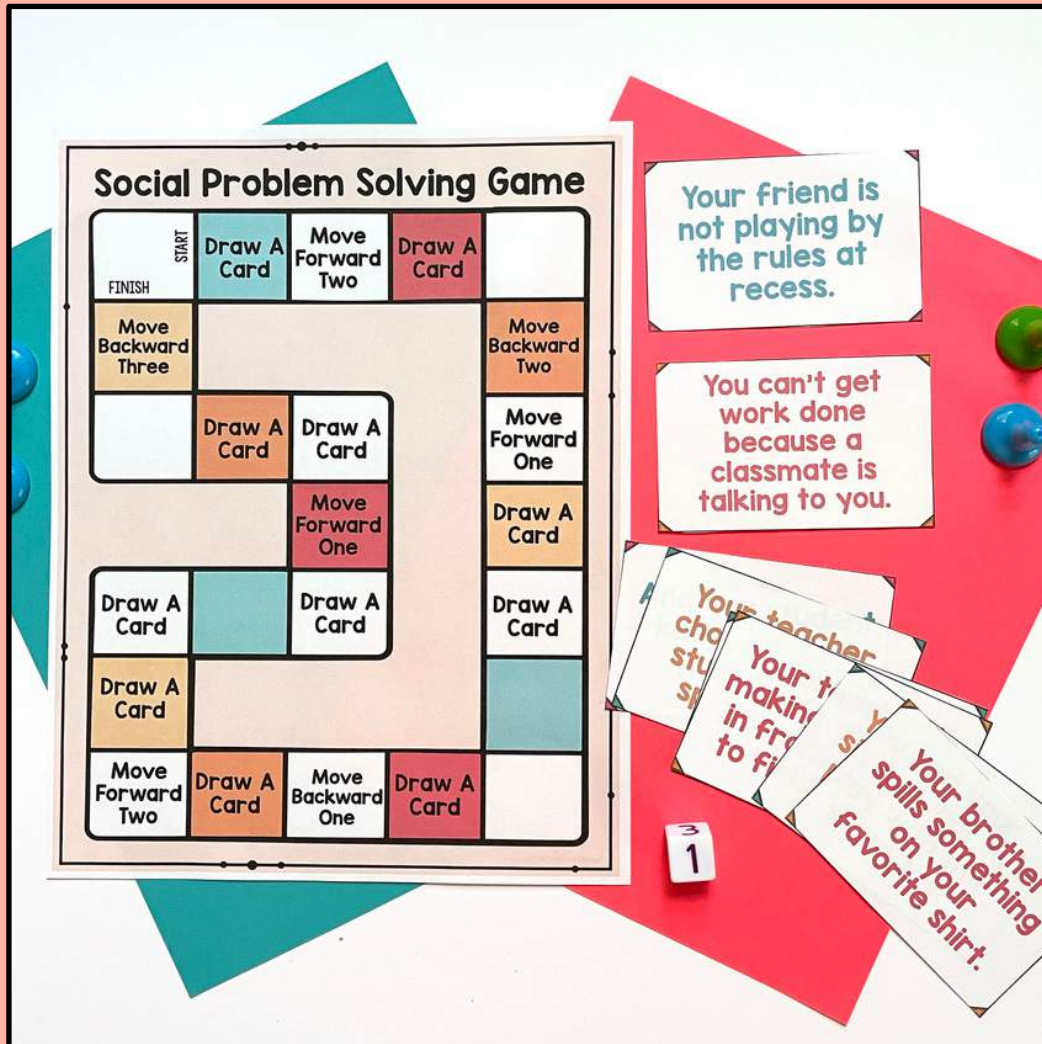
# In these games, students will have fun as they learn to solve problems instead of reacting to their emotions.

- Students who have ADHD

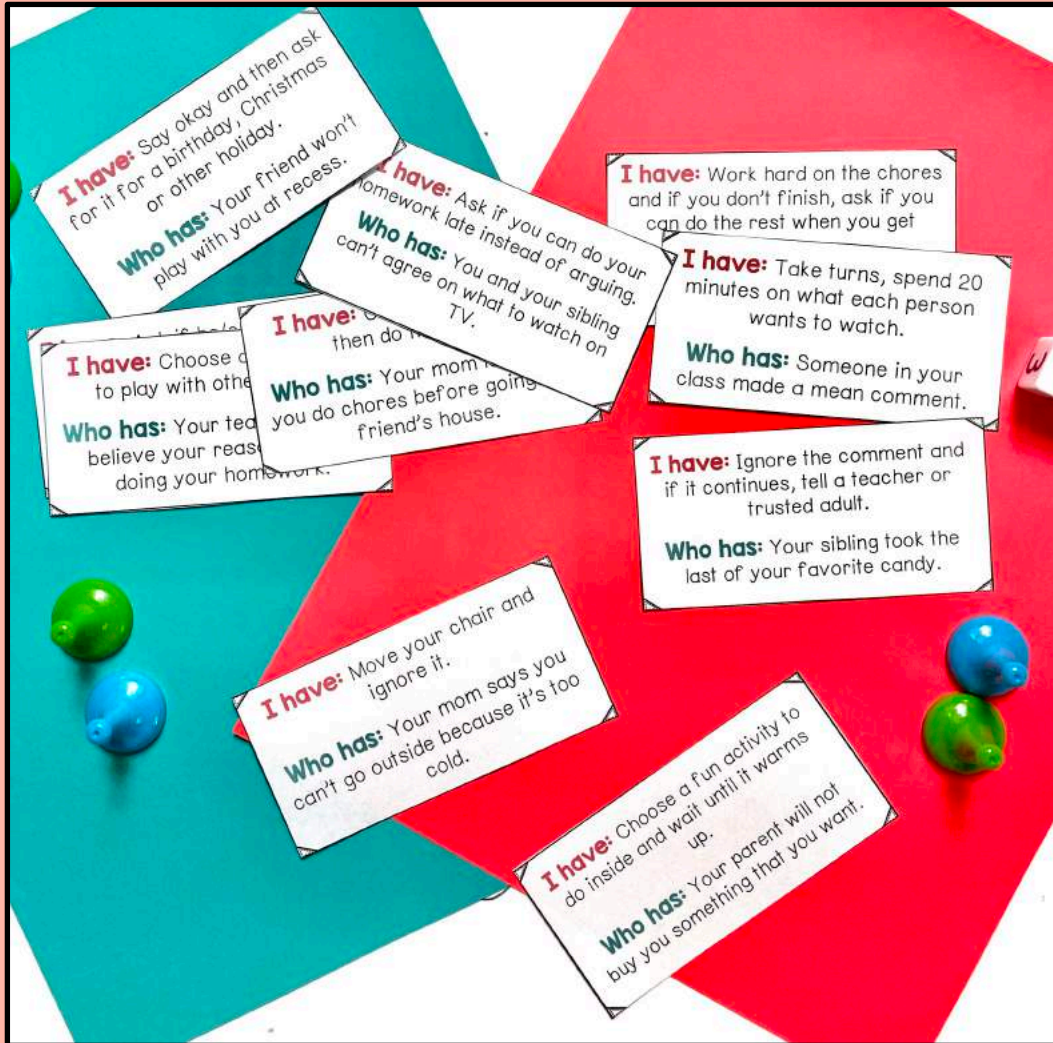
# BOARD GAME

There are also includes 8 blank cards that you can use to write in your own prompts based on your students' needs.

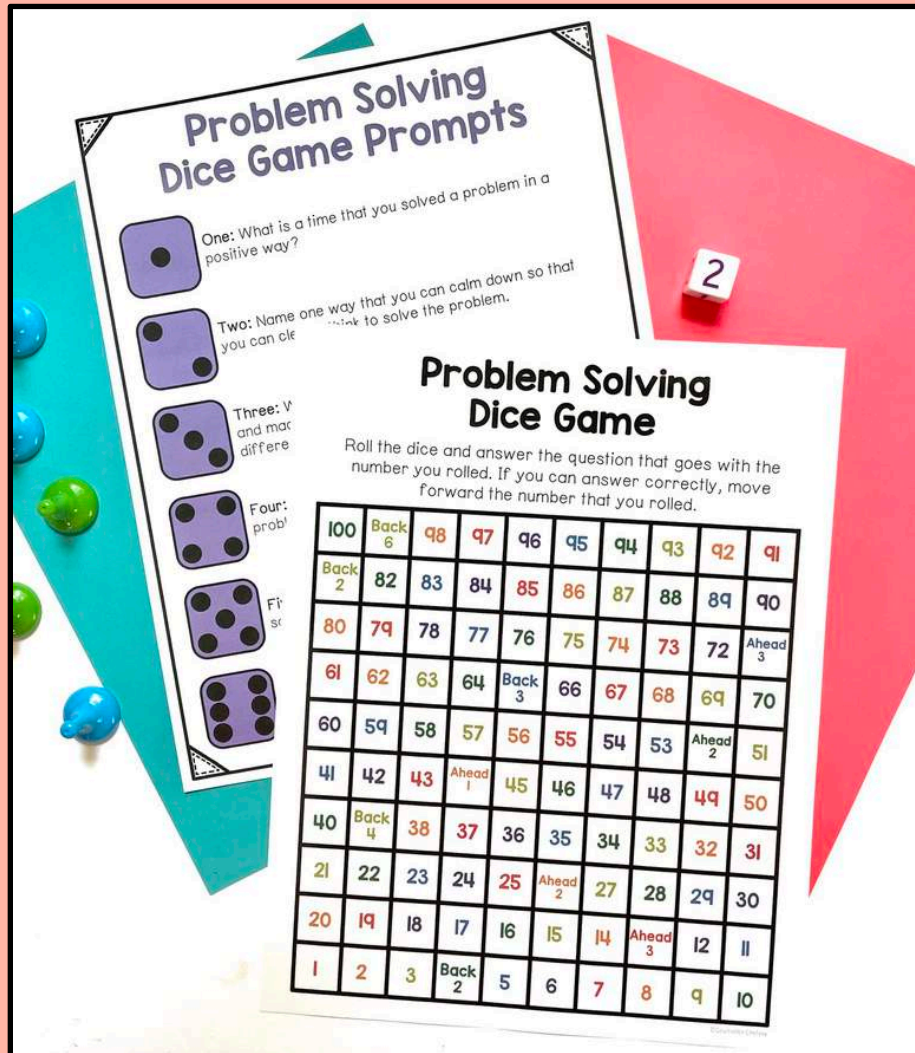
# “I HAVE, WHO HAS”

The prompts will help students reflect on how they currently respond to their problems, and how they can learn to solve them instead of react to them.

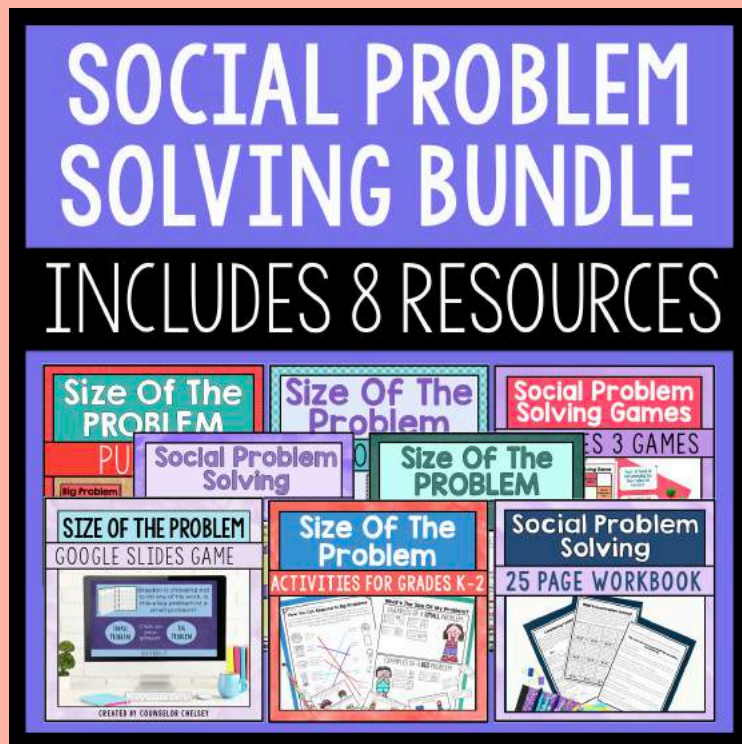
