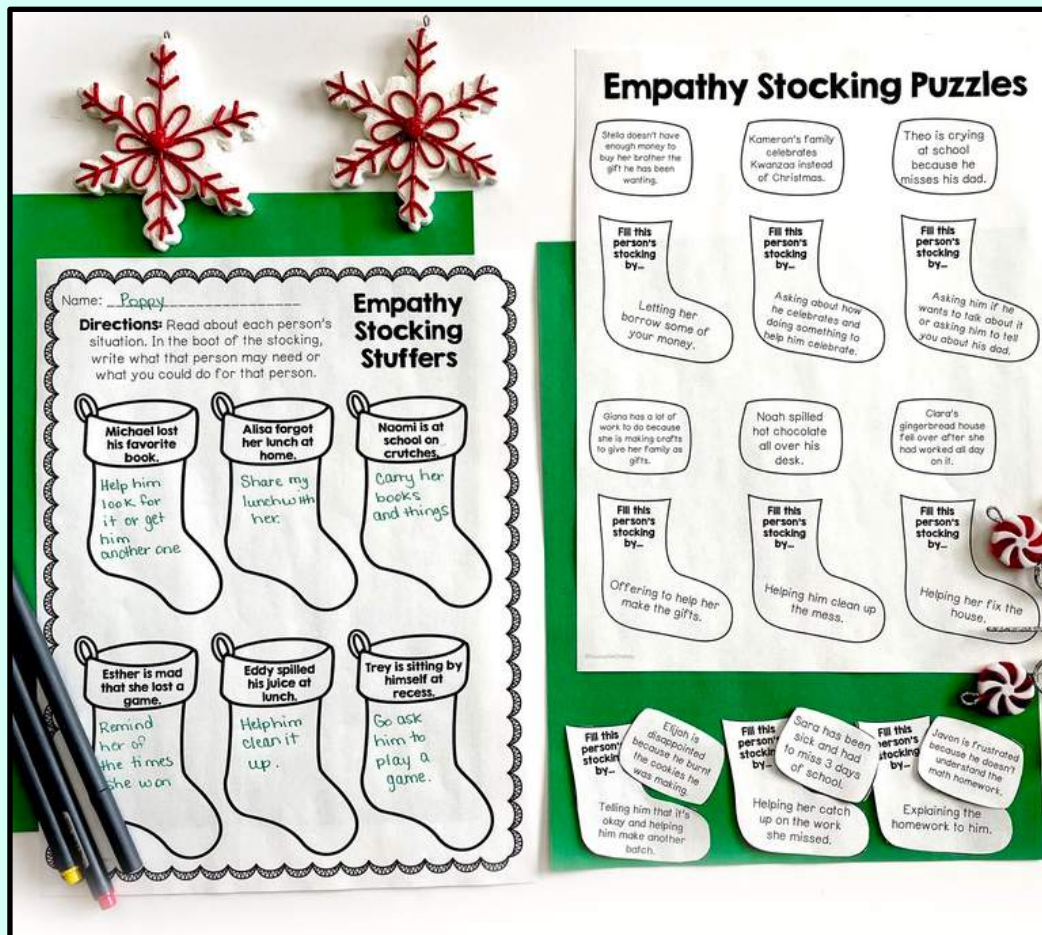


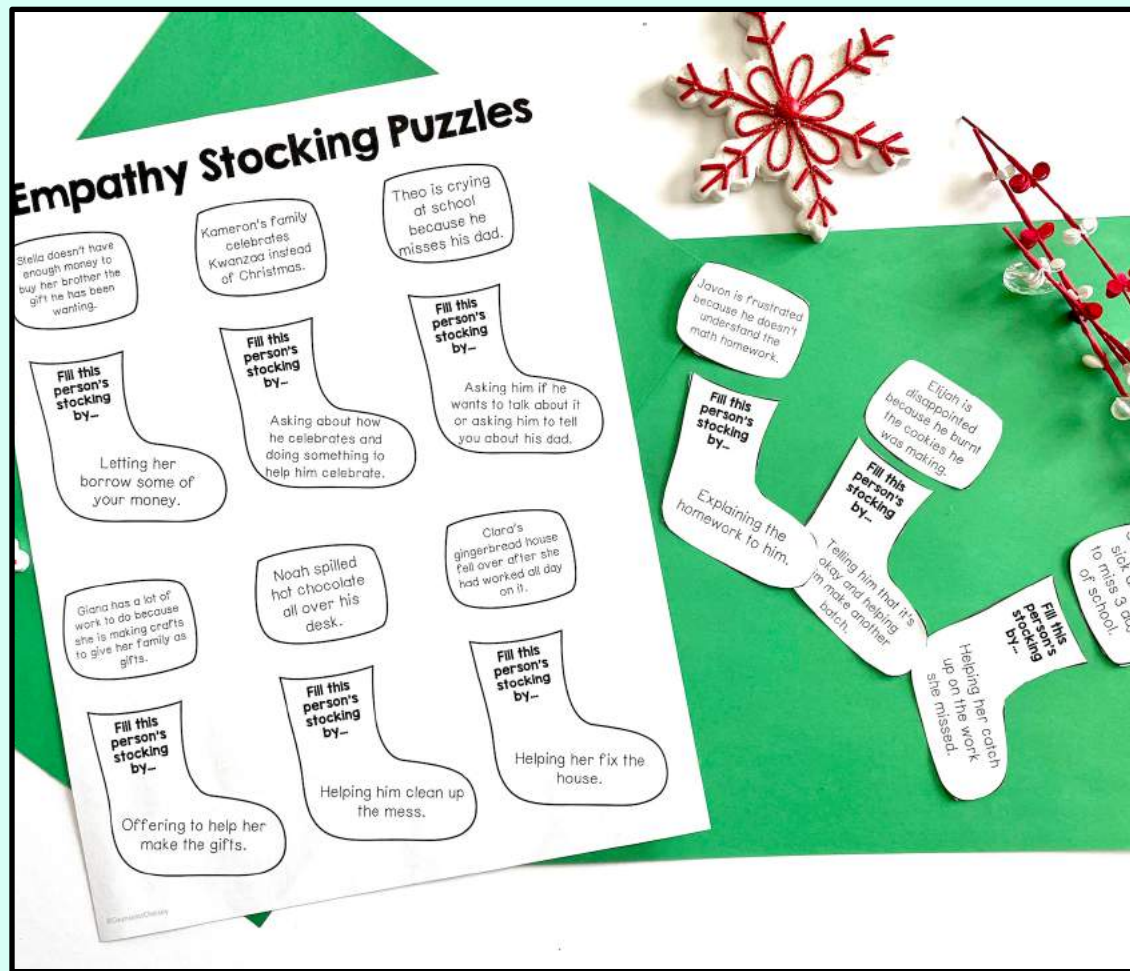
Use these seasonal activities to help your students learn about and practice empathy!

Name: Poppy

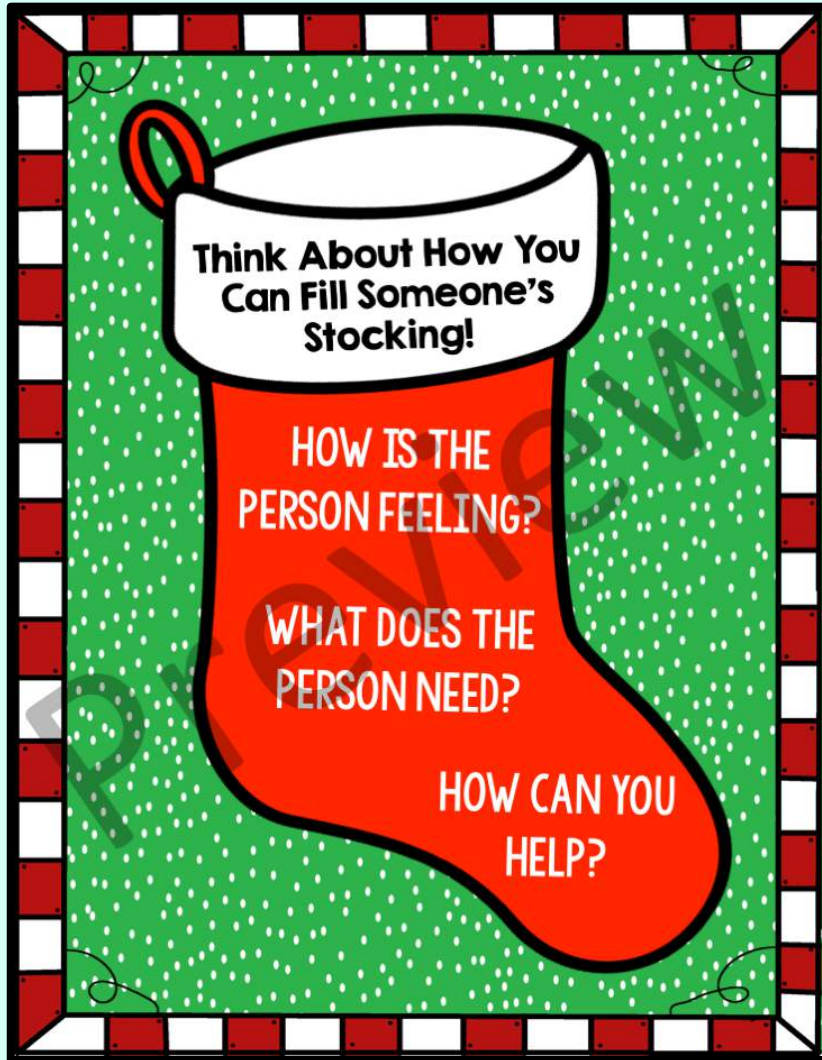
Directions: Read about each person's situation. In the boot of the stocking, write what that person may need or what you could do for that person.

<p>Michael lost his favorite book.</p> <p>Help him look for it or get him another one.</p>	<p>Ailsa forgot her lunch at home.</p> <p>Share my lunch with her.</p>	<p>Naomi is at school on crutches.</p> <p>Carry her books and things.</p>
<p>Esther is mad that she lost a game.</p> <p>Remind her of the times she won.</p>	<p>Eddy spilled his juice at lunch.</p> <p>Help him clean it up.</p>	<p>Trey is sitting by himself at recess.</p> <p>Go ask him to play a game.</p>

Students will look at 6 scenarios and then determine how they can “fill that person’s stocking” by responding empathetically.
