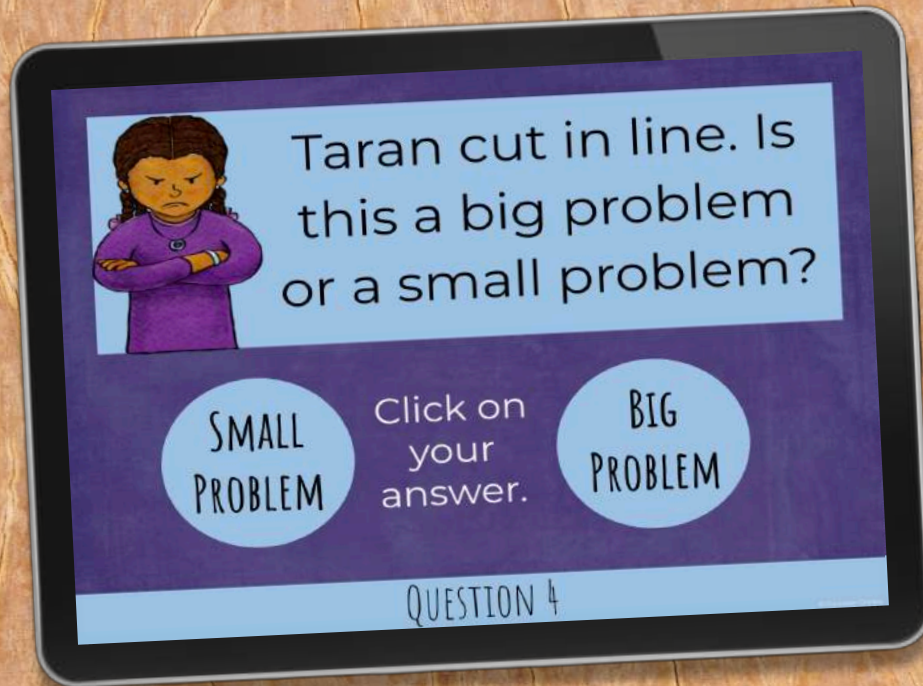

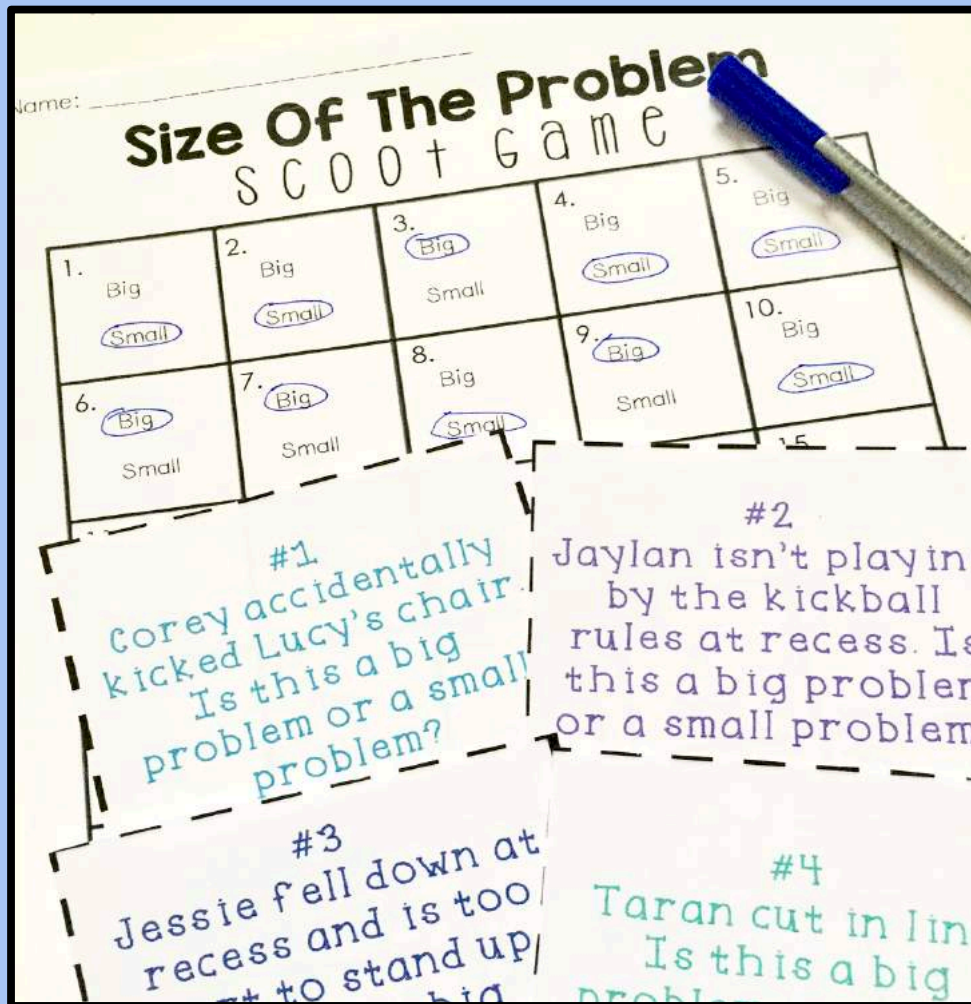
**#28**

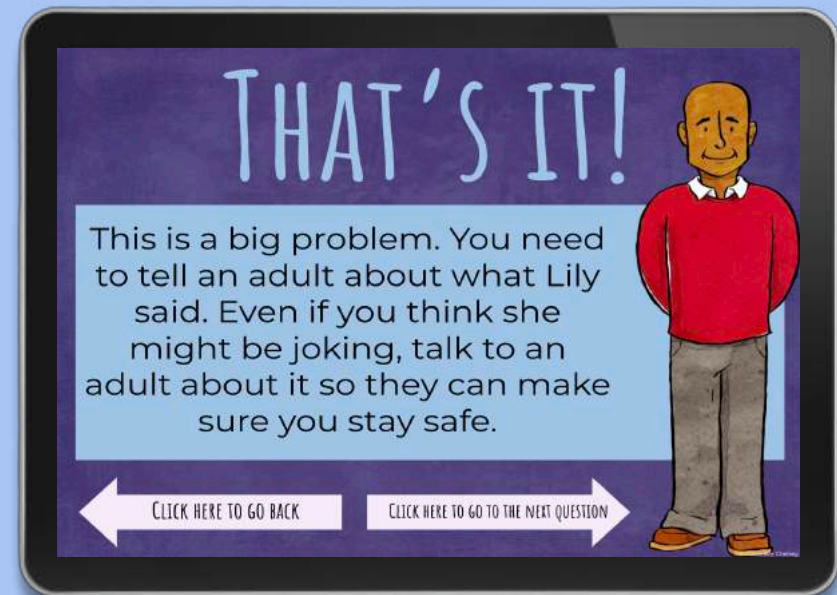
